Additional Guidelines for Application

1. Report GRE and TOEFL scores electronically directly to the institution.

2. Submit two sets of each transcript only after you have marked your application complete and submitted it.
3. Send two sets of each transcript directly to the graduate program to which you are applying. For Atmospheric Science, Hydrologic Sciences, and Soils & Biogeochemistry, send to:

4. In the case of multiple applications, transcripts should be sent only to your first choice of graduate program or to the first completed graduate program application. Those transcripts will be made available to faculty in each graduate program to which you have applied as well as for the review of the fellowship application.
5. All letters of recommendation must be submitted electronically by the referee, through the on-line application. The on-line application will automatically notify the referee and provide instructions on how to submit his/her letter.
